Degree program students are encouraged to have a local mentor throughout their time of studies with Shiloh University. Mentors provide an additional support to degree seeking students; being available to discuss what they are learning and any unique problems or challenges they face through their studies. A number of courses will have assignments asking the student to share their thoughts with a mentor.

A mentor can be the student's local pastor, a lay church ministry, spiritual father, seminary instructor, or a seminary graduate student. The University also recognizes that some students may already be part of a ministry team or may be in an active mentoring program – individuals in these roles may also make suitable mentors for a student.

Student responsibility:

- Identify and contact a mentor
- Fill in and sign the student section of the mentor form
- Provide mentor with the student signed mentor form and have the mentor read and sign the form
- Mail the form to Shiloh University
- Maintain an ongoing relationship with their mentor

Mentor responsibility:

- Read mentor form
- Complete and sign the mentor section of the mentor form
- Be available to discuss or review specific assignments with the student
- Periodically check in with the student / encourage the student

The mentoring relationship is between the student and their mentor. Shiloh University will not discuss the student with the mentor should they contact us due to FERPA requirements. However, if a mentor would like to contact us regarding how to be a more effective mentor or issues with being a mentor, they should feel free to do so.
