

**Articulation Agreement Between  
Shiloh University and Global University**  
June 27, 2011

**I. Statement of Cooperation**

Shiloh University and Global University wish to facilitate the transfer of credit from Global University to Shiloh University and to increase the learning options available to Shiloh University students and faculty. Shiloh University and Global University will maintain the integrity of their separate programs and admissions requirements.

**II. Agreement for Specific Undergraduate Courses**

1. Providing Specific Undergraduate General Education Courses  
Shiloh University, in order to complete its undergraduate general education course offerings, will direct students to, and accept transfer credits from, selected Global University undergraduate courses. See schedule below.
2. Providing Specific Undergraduate Elective Courses  
Shiloh University, in order to fill in its undergraduate elective course offerings, will direct students to, and accept transfer credits from, selected Global University undergraduate courses. See schedule below.

**III. Agreement for Providing Additional Graduate and Undergraduate Elective Courses**

1. Providing Additional Undergraduate Elective Courses  
Shiloh University, in order to fill in its undergraduate program's elective course offerings, will direct students to, and accept transfer credits from, Global University undergraduate courses. These courses will be pre-approved by Shiloh University student advisors.
2. Providing Graduate Elective Courses  
Shiloh University, in order to fill in its graduate programs, elective course offerings, will direct students to, and accept transfer credits from, selected Global University graduate courses. These courses will be pre-approved by Shiloh University student advisors.

**IV. Description of arrangement in the Shiloh University Catalog**

Shiloh University will describe its arrangement with Global University and provide a link to Global University's website in the Shiloh University website and catalog.

**V. Transfer Policies**

Shiloh University extends its acceptance of transfer credits to Global University students according to its stated transfer credit policies published in its most current academic catalog.

Shiloh University and Global University should review this agreement annually to determine if it is achieving its purposes and continuing to meet our institutions' needs.
