ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

COLUMBIA SOUTHERN UNIVERSITY

AND

SHILOH UNIVERSITY

1. Purpose

The purpose of this transfer agreement between Columbia Southern University (CSU) located at 21982 University Lane, Orange Beach, Alabama 36561 and Shiloh University located at 100 Shiloh Drive, Kalona, Iowa 52247 is to establish transfer criteria for undergraduate credit earned in the Associate of Arts that can be applied to the following degree programs: Bachelor of Science in Organizational Leadership, Bachelor of Science in Psychology and Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (General). In addition, this agreement provides a pathway for Shiloh University students earning a Bachelor of Arts in Biblical and Pastoral Studies into CSU's graduate degree programs.

2. Background

CSU is an undergraduate and graduate level institution that is accredited by the Distance Education and Training Council (DETC), which is listed by the U.S. Department of Education as a nationally recognized accrediting agency. As an accredited, degree-granting member of the DETC, CSU is also an institutional member of the Council for Higher Education Accreditation. CSU is licensed by the State of Alabama, Department of Education pursuant to the Alabama Private School License Law Code of Alabama, Title 16-46-1 through 10. Columbia Southern University is an Institutional member of the American Council on Education (ACE). CSU is a title IV school approved for federal financial aid, Veterans Administration benefits and tuition reimbursement for active duty military personnel through the Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support (DANTES).

Shiloh University and its degree programs are nationally accredited by the Accrediting Commission of the Distance Education and Training Council (DETC). DETC is a recognized member of the Council for Higher Education Accreditation and is listed by the U.S. Department of Education as a nationally recognized accrediting agency. The purpose of Shiloh University is to nurture in its students a personal relationship with God, and a true knowledge of the Bible, His Word. The University is committed to teaching biblical principles and equipping men and women in the application of these principles in their lives and ministries by providing high-quality, practical, and affordable online / distance learning courses to a world-wide audience.

3. Articulation Agreement Elements

The bachelor of science degrees offered by CSU include one hundred twenty semester hours of general education, major and elective courses. CSU will accept Shiloh University's courses listed on the attached transfer grids for equivalent general education, major and elective courses. In the bachelor's degree programs, students must successfully complete a minimum of thirty six (36) upper level semester hours at CSU or an institution authorized to award upper level credits. Students attending CSU must complete a minimum of 25% of their degree program at CSU to meet graduation requirements. For entrance to a master's degree program at CSU, students must have a conferred bachelor's degree from an accredited institution. Documents that will be considered for credit transfer consideration are: college/military transcripts, training certificates and credit by examination (CLEP, DANTES and Excelsior).



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4. Learning Partnership

This articulation agreement includes a Learning Partnership between CSU and Shiloh University. The benefits of the Learning Partnership with CSU include: Shiloh University students, alumni and staff members, along with their respective spouses and children, will receive a 10% tuition discount and a waiver of the application for admission fee and eligibility for scholarships.

5. Commitment

CSU and Shiloh University are committed to serve our students and use technology to facilitate the transfer of students between both institutions. Students participating in the program must meet all criteria for admission into CSU and comply with all requirements in the awarding of a degree. This agreement will remain in effect for a period of five (5) years from the date of signature, but may be terminated by either party by providing a written notification to the other party. CSU and Shiloh University should review the agreement annually to determine whether it is achieving the desired results and continuing to meet our institutions needed. This agreement may be executed by duly authorized representatives of each party, either by electronic facsimile or other digital means, each of which will be considered as original.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, either party may terminate the Agreement immediately in the event that participation under the Agreement may give rise to a violation of any requirement of federal or state law or regulation or the requirements of any accrediting agency having jurisdiction.
