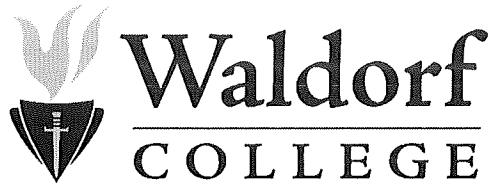


Transfer Agreement

This Transfer Agreement ("Agreement") between Waldorf College, 106 South 6th Street, Forest City, Iowa 50436 ("Waldorf") and Shiloh University, 100 Shiloh Dr., Kalona, Iowa 52247 ("Shiloh") executed by both parties and becomes effective when the final required signature and date is entered on this document. This agreement establishes a credit transfer policy for college credit earned at Shiloh which may be transferred into Waldorf's residential and online degree programs. This agreement is intended to facilitate the credit transfer process for Shiloh students who desire to continue their education at Waldorf.

Waldorf College Residential Degree Programs

Features, Benefits, & Transfer Policy for Waldorf's Residential Programs

Students who have earned an Associate in Arts Degree (A.A.) from Shiloh will have all Waldorf general education core requirements waived; except Religion 103 Introduction to Biblical Literature and an upper division religion course (300+ level).

A maximum of 84 semester hours in the bachelor's degree programs may be transferred into Waldorf, providing the credits are relevant and in alignment with the applicable degree program. Acceptance of courses and credits from the Shiloh and other accredited institutions are evaluated by the Registrar according to the nature and quality of the coursework. A minimum GPA of 2.0 from the transferring institution is required for admission into Waldorf.

Under this agreement, Shiloh students, faculty, staff members, their spouse and their children who enter Waldorf's residential programs will have the standard application fee waived and receive a \$500.00 scholarship toward the first year's tuition.

All full-time students must live on campus and be on a board plan except those who: are married, have children, are living with parents at the permanent address and commuting within a 35-mile radius, have senior status prior to the first day of the semester (86 credits

earned) have transferred in with a minimum of 30 transferable credits prior to the first day of classes, are part-time status, have veteran status, or are at minimum 21 years old prior to the first day of the semester. Student housing is available for married couples upon request.

Waldorf College Online Degree Programs

Features, Benefits, and Transfer Policy for Waldorf's Online Programs

Students who have earned an Associate of Arts degree from an accredited institution will have their degree considered for meeting all core requirements with the exception of a lower-division religion course and an upper division religion course, and any specific courses required by the individual major area of study.

A maximum of 90 (ninety) semester hours may be transferred into Waldorf's online Bachelor's Degree programs, providing they are relevant and in alignment with the applicable degree program. A minimum letter grade of C minus or better is required for credit transfer consideration. Since Shiloh does not use letter grades, 70% or higher will be equivalent to a C-. Students entering Waldorf's Online Degree Programs must have a High School Diploma or a General Education Development Certificate (GED).

Shiloh students, faculty, staff members, their spouses and children enrolling in Waldorf's Online Degree Program will receive a 10 (ten) percent tuition discount and a waiver of the application fee. These discounts are offered through Waldorf's Tuition Discount Program. In addition, textbooks are provided at no cost under Waldorf's book grant program.

Application Process for Residential and Online Programs

Students may apply to Waldorf at any time during or after their enrollment at Shiloh. Additionally this agreement extends to Shiloh alumni, faculty, employees, their spouse and children. Applicants may apply at: <http://www.waldorf.edu/apply-now/>. Applicants are welcome to provide additional information in support of their application. Academic Counselors at Waldorf College are available to discuss any personal matter which may have impacted the applicant's previous academic performance.

Under this agreement, students may attend Shiloh and Waldorf concurrently. Students will have access to academic advising and other services at both institutions.

Academic Accommodations

Waldorf College provides appropriate academic accommodations to students with a diagnosed learning disability or other documented conditions that would impact a student's ability to learn or demonstrate their academic progress. Students need to contact the Disabilities Specialist in the Academic Achievement Center for Excellence (AACE) to request and set up academic accommodations.

Accreditation and Affiliations

Shiloh University and its degree programs are nationally accredited by the Distance Education Accrediting Commission (DEAC). DEAC is a recognized member of the Council for Higher Education Accreditation by the U. S. Department of Education as a nationally recognized accrediting agency. The purpose of Shiloh University is to nurture in its students a personal relationship with God, and a true knowledge of the Bible, His Word. The University is committed to teaching biblical principles and equipping men and women in the application of these principles in their lives and ministries by providing high-quality, practical and affordable online / distance learning courses to a world-wide audience.

Waldorf College represents and warrants that it is regionally accredited through the: Higher Learning Commission (HLC) of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools, 230 LaSalle Street, Suite 7-500, Chicago, IL. 60604. Waldorf is a signatory on the DoD Voluntary Education Partnership Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). A participant in the USAF Air University Associate to Baccalaureate Cooperative (AU-ABC) and a non-LOI school in the U. S. Army's GoArmyEd program.

If either party listed within this agreement experiences a change in their accreditation, the party experiencing the accreditation change will provide written notification of said change to the other party within 90 (ninety) days. Written notification of the accreditation change will be dispatched to the current president of the receiving institution.


Shiloh and Waldorf agree to promote their partnership. This may include, but not limited to; printed or electronically distributed materials.

Signature Page

This agreement will remain in effect for a period of 5 (five) years from the date of signature. This agreement may be terminated by written notification and will become effective 60 days after receipt. Notification of termination must be sent to the President of the receiving institution.

The signed agreement between Waldorf and Shiloh may be delivered via facsimile or other digital means and will be considered an original document.
